SECURITY TIPS

SCAMMER ARE POSING AS TRUSTED ORGANIZATIONS

Scammers are getting smarter—and they're targeting older adults by posing as banks, well-known companies, or government agencies. Their goal? To scare people into sending money or sharing personal information.

They often create a fake crisis to cause panic and urgency. Here are some of the most common lies they use:

● Common Scam Lies:

- "Someone is using your account."
- A scammer may claim to be from your bank or Amazon, warning you of suspicious activity.
- "Your identity is linked to a crime."
- They might pretend to be from Social Security or law enforcement, saying your info is tied to criminal activity.
- "There's a problem with your computer."
- A pop-up or fake tech support message says your computer is hacked, asking you to call a number for help.

✓ Protect Yourself:

- Don't move or send money because of a call or message, no matter how urgent it seems.
- Never give personal info to someone who contacts you unexpectedly.
- Talk to someone you trust before taking action.
- Verify the story by contacting the organization directly—never use the number or link in the message.

⊘ Remember:

Government agencies and trusted companies will never ask you to:

- Transfer money to "protect" it
- Buy gift cards or Bitcoin
- Hand cash to a courier
