DID YOU KNOW?

Just a reminder that as of May 3, 2023, every air traveler 18 years of age and older will need a Real ID-compliant driver's license, state-issued enhanced driver's license, or another acceptable form of ID to fly within the United States. U.S. passports are Real ID-approved. This means if you were to fly domestically and do not have a new ID, you can use your passport as a type of identification. EARLY BIRD SPECIAL if booked by June 30, 2021.


New England Rails & Sails



BEWARE OF IDENTITY THEFT SCAMS AND TACTICS

Here are some tips & tricks to stay alert to common scams.

Mail Theft

Use a locking, security mailbox if possible, or consider renting a P.O. box at your local post office. Put outgoing mail into a postal mailbox not your own.

Dumpster Diving (trash theft)

Shred unwanted documents containing personal information and all unsolicited credit card or loan offers. Invest in a high-quality cross-cut shredder. Thieves can piece together papers shredded into horizontal stripes.

Shoulder Surfing

“Shoulder Surfers” observe your actions or eavesdrop to steal personal information. They look over your shoulder or stand close by and may use a camera phone to record you.

Shield keypads with your hand or body before entering PINs, passwords, or card numbers. If at a keypad at a store, push the “credit” button when using your debit card and do a signature. This protects your PIN number even further.

Avoid sharing personal information over the phone in public. If you must, use a low voice and shield your mouth.

Purse or Wallet Snatching

Minimize what you carry in your wallet, especially payment cards. NEVER, EVER carry your social security card unless absolutely necessary. Don't carry PINs or account passwords with you; memorize them or keep them safely stored at home.
