

Lunch will be a sandwich on homemade bread, with a side of homemade Italian pasta salad, chips, and cookie.



Elder Scams & Fraud

Older adults are targeted every day via the *internet, email, texts, social media, mail, in-person, and by telephone*. Nearly every scam is designed to trick an older adult into sending money or providing their personal information. With the elderly population growing and seniors racking up more than \$3 billion in losses annually, elder scams and fraud are a growing problem.

What are the signs?

- · Calling or emailing you, claiming to be from the government and asking you for money.
- · Asking you to pay money or taxes upfront to receive a prize or a gift.
- Asking for access to your finances such as your ATM cards, bank accounts, credit cards, investment accounts.
- Pressuring you to "act now" or else the deal will go away OR someone who seems to be trying hard to give you a "great deal" without time to answer your questions.

How you can help

- · Recognize scam attempts and end all communication with the perpetrator.
- Search Online for the contact information (name, email, phone number, address) and the proposed offer. Other people have likely posted information online about individuals and businesses trying to run scams.
- Take precautions to protect your identity. If a criminal gains access to your device or account, immediately contact your financial institution to place protections on your accounts, and monitor your accounts and personal information for suspicious activity.
- Never give or send any personally identifiable information, money, jewelry, gift cards, checks, or wire information to unverified people or businesses.
- · Make sure all computer anti-virus and security software and malware protections are up-to-date.
