### Brandt House-Historic Flint Hills Hotel-

- On July 18<sup>th</sup>, at Brandt House (402 Missouri Ave, Alma, KS 66401), Bank of the Flint Hills customers attending the Legacy Birthday Lunch will have the privilege to hear about and tour the Brandt House.

Brandt House is a restored historic limestone hotel located in the heart of the Flint Hills. The property was built in 1887 as a two-story ell-shaped with 17 rooms for the anticipated boom due to the Rock Island Railway. For many years, the hotel was host to many salesmen, politicians, and travelers visiting Alma. The hotel was sold several times through the years, but one interesting purchase was in 1962, when it was sold to the Herbert Bute family. The hotel became well-known for its French restaurant, with a piece done by Wendall Anschutz. Anschutz wrote and produced a travelogue series titled "Place to Place", each story was related to a person or place from the region. Famous names that visited the French restaurant and hotel were Susan Ford, daughter of former U.S. President Gerald Ford and former First Lady Betty Ford. Charles Kuralt was an American television, newspaper, radio journalist and author. Kuralt is widely known for his "On the Road" segments on The Cbs Evening News with Walter Cronkite.

The property would go on to change hands several more times, until operations ceased and the building set empty for several decades. Today there is seven uniquely designed rooms.



# SECURITY TIPS

## NATIONWIDE TEXT MESSAGE SCAM

As technology changes, so do the ways scammers try to take advantage of people. One of the latest scams involves fake text messages that look like they're from official places, like the Kansas DMV or Department of Transportation. These messages claim you owe money for unpaid tolls, and they're designed to make you panic and act quickly. We know how overwhelming this kind of thing can be, especially when it shows up out of the blue. That's why we want to keep you informed and prepared. In the sections below, you'll find clear, simple tips to help you spot scams, protect your information, and know what to do if something doesn't feel right. We're here to help you stay safe.

### 🚩 How to Spot a Scam Message

Scam texts often:

- Say you owe money or there's a problem with your account
- Use urgent language like "final notice" or "immediate action required."
- Contain links to click or ask you to reply with personal information
- If you weren't expecting the message, or it feels rushed or threatening, it's probably a scam.

### 🚫 What NOT to Do

- Don't click on any links in a text or email unless you're absolutely sure it's from a trusted source.
- Don't respond to the message, even to say "stop" or "unsubscribe."
- Never share personal details like your Social Security number, bank account, or credit card info in a text or over the phone unless you initiated the contact.

### ✅ What You SHOULD Do

- Delete the message right away if it seems suspicious.
- Call the company or agency directly using a number you trust (like the one on your billing statement or from their official website).
- Tell someone you trust—like a family member or your banker—if you get a message that doesn't feel right.

### 🔒 Easy Habits to Stay Protected

- Keep your phone and computer updated. These updates often include security fixes.
- Be careful with unknown numbers. If you don't recognize who's texting or calling, it's okay to ignore it.
- Check with us anytime. If a message says it's about your account or payment and it seems suspicious, give your branch a call—we're happy to help check.
